FUN FACTS BRAZIL

1. Brazil is the country with the fifth largest population in the world, after China, India, the USA and Indonesia.
2. The biggest cities in Brazil are São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro and Brasilia.
3. The Amazon River is the 2nd longest river in the world and it flows through Brazil.
4. Around 60 percent of the Amazon Rainforest is found in Brazil.
5. Brasilia is the capital of Brazil.
6. São Paulo is the largest city in Brazil.
7. Brazil is the largest country in South America.
8. Football (soccer) is the most popular sport in Brazil.
9. Norway is the only national football team in the world that has never lost to Brazil. (2 wins and 2 draws).
10. The giant relative of the guinea pig, the capybara, is found in Brazil.
11. The Christ the Redeemer statue is found in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil and is its most famous landmark.
12. The national animal of Brazil is the jaguar.
13. Brazil's national dish is feijoada, a stew that includes beans, beef and pork.
14. The Copacabana beach is the site of the largest concert in history. 3.5 million people came to see Rod Stewart there in 1994.
15. Brazil is the only country on the planet where both the Equator and the Tropic of Capricorn run through.
16. Recife, the country's fourth largest city is also nicknamed 'Venice of Brazil' because of its over 50 bridges and many waterways.
17. At Ronaldo da Silva prison in Santa Rita Do Sapucaí, Brazil allows inmates to pedal stationary bicycles that power street lights in a nearby city in exchange for reduced sentences.
18. There is an island off the coast of Brazil that has so many venomous snakes (1-5 snakes per square meter) that the Brazilian navy has quarantined it. It is called 'Snake Island'.

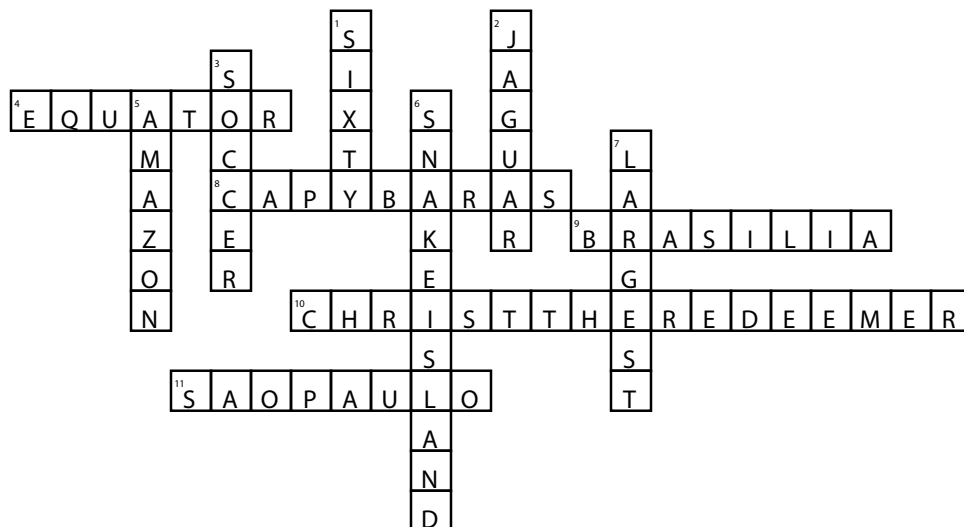
